Commencement of Membership Sales for Grand HIMEDIC Club “HIMEDIC Midtown”

Resorttrust, Inc. (the “Company”) announces the commencement tomorrow of membership sales for Grand HIMEDIC Club “HIMEDIC Midtown” as a comprehensive medical support club by High Technology Medical Complex (HIMEDIC) Co., Ltd., a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company.

By entrusting screening services to the Midtown Clinic Medical Corporation, which operates the Tokyo Midtown Medical Center, HIMEDIC Midtown has put in place a system to enable a high rate of early diagnosis for various types of cancer throughout the body, as well as cranial nerve and cardiovascular diseases, using state-of-the-art medical equipment including PET/CT scanners (administered by advanced medical institutions such as the Japan Red Cross Medical Center) and 3.0 tesla MRI scanners. In addition to providing referrals to the most appropriate medical institution in the event that a problem is detected, the Club’s doctors offer a caring response to day-to-day worries, based on the cumulative data about the member collected over the years at each clinic.

Tokyo Midtown Medical Center is the only medical facility in Japan affiliated with America’s highest-ranking medical institution, Johns Hopkins Medicine International*, and services specially designed for women have been set up at HIMEDIC Midtown, making it possible to offer total support including all private rooms, gynecological testing carried out by female specialists and female staff, as well as cosmetic medicine and aesthetic dentistry. Additional optional tests include testing for risk of brain dysfunction, and genetic testing complete with a system for counseling by clinical genetic specialists and certified genetic counselors.

HIMEDIC operates a comprehensive medical support club which became the world’s first such facility to offer PET scan screening at HIMEDIC Yamanakako in 1994. With the establishment of HIMEDIC Osaka in 2005, followed by HIMEDIC The University of Tokyo Hospital in 2006, a network of three locations was formed. With more than about 80,000 screenings performed at these three medical institutions over 19 years, HIMEDIC has built up a record of achievements in areas including support for disease prevention through advice on lifestyle changes before problems arise, as well as early detection of cancer and other illnesses.

The number of members at HIMEDIC has been growing steadily amid rising interest in health issues, reaching

8,644 by the end of May 2013, and the existing three facilities are almost at full capacity for screening. Furthermore, given that women account for roughly 40 percent of screenings, demand for screenings for gynecological problems and other tests tailored particularly for women is considered to be high.

The Grand HIMEDIC Club “HIMEDIC Midtown” is offering membership contracts for ¥2,250,000 (initial fees: ¥2,250,000, annual membership fee: ¥500,000 (prices excluding consumption tax.))

Screenings at HIMEDIC Midtown are scheduled to commence in October 2013, and approximately 1,100 memberships are being offered initially. Membership contracts in the fiscal year ending March 31, 2014 are expected to total about ¥500 million.
